Upgrading Your LightPainter Application for Production Like any other production application, you'll want to deploy your LightPainter app with the following changes: Preload the assets: When your LightPainter application launches, the app server will look for assets that must be preloaded. These are static assets that the user will not need to download or stream from the cloud. In my example, I preload the JQuery library, which will be required to run the application.
